3 elections to be held on Saturday and Sunday and
4 prohibiting second primaries.

6 It is proposed by the Florida Constitution Revision Commission
7 that:

9 Section 1. Section 5 of Article VI of the Florida in
10 revised by amending that section to read:
11 ARTICLE VI
12 SUFFRAGE AND ELECTIONS
13 SECTION 5. General and special elections.--A general
14 election shall be held in each county on the first Tuesday
15 after the first Monday in November of each even-numbered year
16 to choose a successor to each elective state and county
17 officer whose term will expire before the next general
18 election and, except as provided herein, to fill each vacancy
19 in elective office for the unexpired portion of the term. Only
20 one primary election for the nomination of candidates for
21 political parties may be held prior to the general election.A
22 general election may be suspended or delayed due to a state of
23 emergency or impending emergency pursuant to general law.
24 Special elections and referenda shall be held as provided by
25 law.
