6 It is proposed by the Florida Constitution Revision Commission
7 that:

9 Section 1. Section 22 of Article I of the Florida
10 Constitution is revised by amending that section to read:

11 ARTICLE I

12 DECLARATION OF RIGHTS

13 SECTION 22. Trial by jury.--The right of trial by jury
14 shall be secure to all and remain inviolate. The
15 qualifications and the number of jurors, not fewer than six,
16 shall be fixed by law. This section notwithstanding, the
17 parties to an action to establish paternity are not entitled
18 to a trial by jury.
