12 SECTION 2. Electors.--Every citizen of the United
13 States who is at least eighteen ~~twenty-one~~ years of age and
14 who ~~is has been~~ a permanent resident ~~of for one year in~~ the
15 state ~~and six months in a county~~, if registered as provided by
16 law, shall be an elector of that county. ~~Provisions may be~~
17 ~~made by law for other bona fide residents of the state who are~~
18 ~~at least twenty-one years of age to vote in the election of~~
19 ~~presidential electors.~~
