ARTICLE XI

AMENDMENTS

3 SECTION 3. Initiative.--The power to propose the
4 revision or amendment of any portion or portions of this
5 constitution by initiative is reserved to the people, provided
6 that, any such revision or amendment, except for those
7 limiting the power of government to raise revenue, shall
8 embrace but one subject and matter directly connected
9 therewith. Any such initiative that limits the powers of
10 municipalities or that limits or affects the authority or
11 ability of municipalities to raise revenue shall not take
12 effect in any particular municipality unless approved by a
13 vote of the electors of that particular municipality. The
14 initiative process It may be invoked by filing with the
15 secretary of state a petition containing a copy of the
16 proposed revision or amendment, signed by a number of electors
17 in each of one half of the congressional districts of the
18 state, and of the state as a whole, equal to eight percent of
19 the votes cast in each of such districts respectively and in
20 the state as a whole in the last preceding election in which
21 presidential electors were chosen.
