

1 A proposal to revise
2 ARTICLE VI, s. 1, Fla. Const.; providing that
3 requirements for placing the name of a
4 candidate with no party affiliation or minor
5 party candidate on an election ballot must not
6 be greater than the requirements for major
7 party candidates.

9 It is proposed by the Florida Constitution Revision Commission
10 that:

12 Section 1. Section 1 of ARTICLE VI of the Florida
13 Constitution is revised by amending that section to read:

14 ARTICLE VI

15 SUFFRAGE AND ELECTIONS

16 SECTION 1. Regulation of elections.--All elections by
17 the people shall be by direct and secret vote. General
18 elections shall be determined by a plurality of votes cast.
19 Registration and elections shall, and political party
20 functions may, be regulated by law; however, the requirements
21 of a candidate with no party affiliation or a candidate of a
22 minor party for placement of the candidate's name on the
23 ballot must be no greater than the requirements for a
24 candidate from the party having the largest number of
25 registered voters.
