6 It is proposed by the Florida Constitution Revision Commission  
7 that:

9       Section 1. Section 5 of Article VI of the Florida  
10 Constitution is created to read:  
11                                   ARTICLE VI  
12                                   SUFFRAGE AND ELECTIONS  
13       SECTION 5. Contribution disclosure.--All contributions  
14 to a candidate must be disclosed and listed on the official  
15 ballot, in addition to the candidates name, in the election  
16 for which the contributions are made. This disclosure must  
17 include the total amount of each contribution and the  
18 contributor's name and occupation, or the special interest if  
19 other than a natural person. The legislature shall create the  
20 Campaign Finance Disclosure Trust Fund during the first  
21 regular legislative session following the adoption of this  
22 amendment, to be established by a fee representing a  
23 percentage of total contributions made by non-natural persons.  
24 The fee must be adequate to fund the cost of listing and  
25 disclosing contributions on the ballot. No candidate may  
26 accept any contribution within 30 days prior to the election  
27 for which the contribution is made. Failure to disclose all  
28 contributions in good faith shall constitute a felony of the  
29 third degree.
