3 additional powers and duties for the Lieutenant

6 It is proposed by the Florida Constitution Revision Commission
7 that:

9 Section 1. Section 2 of Article IV of the Florida
10 Constitution is revised by amending that section to read:

11 ARTICLE IV
12 EXECUTIVE

13 SECTION 2. Lieutenant governor.--There shall be a
14 lieutenant governor. He or she shall perform such duties
15 pertaining to the office of governor as shall be assigned to
16 him or her by the governor, except when otherwise provided by
17 law, and such other duties as may be prescribed by law. The
18 lieutenant governor shall preside and have a vote on the
19 cabinet if the governor does not attend a cabinet meeting and
20 requests that the lieutenant governor represent him or her at
21 the meeting.
