2       ARTICLE IV, s. 5, Fla. Const.; providing for  
3       the candidate for the office of governor to run  
4       without a lieutenant governor candidate.

6   It is proposed by the Florida Constitution Revision Commission  
7   that:

9       Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 5 of Article IV  
10   of the Florida Constitution is revised by amending that  
11   subsection to read:  
12                                   ARTICLE IV  
13                                   EXECUTIVE  
14       SECTION 5. Election of governor, lieutenant governor  
15   and cabinet members; qualifications; terms.--  
16       (a) At a state-wide general election in each calendar  
17   year the number of which is even but not a multiple of four,  
18   the electors shall choose a governor and a lieutenant governor  
19   and members of the cabinet each for a term of four years  
20   beginning on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in  
21   January of the succeeding year. In primary elections, all  
22   candidates for the office of governor shall run without a  
23   lieutenant governor candidate.In the general election and in  
24   party primaries, if held, all candidates for the offices of  
25   governor and lieutenant governor shall form joint candidacies  
26   in a manner prescribed by law so that each voter shall cast a  
27   single vote for a candidate for governor and a candidate for  
28   lieutenant governor running together.
