10 It is proposed by the Florida Constitution Revision Commission  
11 that:

13                   Section 1. Section 3 of Article XI of the Florida  
14 Constitution is revised by amending that section to read:

17 SECTION 3. Initiative.--The power to propose the  
18 revision or amendment of any portion or portions of this  
19 constitution by initiative is reserved to the people, provided  
20 that, any such revision or amendment, except for those  
21 limiting the power of government to raise revenue, shall  
22 embrace but one subject and matter directly connected  
23 therewith. It may be invoked by filing with the secretary of  
24 state a petition containing a copy of the proposed revision or  
25 amendment, signed by a number of electors in each of one half  
26 of the congressional districts of the state, and of the state  
27 as a whole, equal to eight percent of the votes cast in each  
28 of such districts respectively and in the state as a whole in  
29 the last preceding election in which presidential electors  
30 were chosen. When a referendum is placed on the ballot as the  
31 result of initiative and that referendum is rejected by the

1 electors, the subject of that initiative and referendum may  
2 not be the subject of another initiative petition until 6  
3 years after the election at which the previous referendum was  
4 rejected.
