Section 8 of Article II of the Florida 10 Constitution is revised by amending that section to read: 11 ARTICLE II 12 GENERAL PROVISIONS 13 SECTION 8. Ethics in government.--A public office is a 14 public trust. The people shall have the right to secure and 15 sustain that trust against abuse. To assure this right: 16 (a) All elected constitutional officers and candidates 17 for such offices and, as may be determined by law, other 18 public officers, candidates, and employees shall file full and 19 public disclosure of their financial interests. 20 (b) All elected public officers and candidates for 21 such offices shall file full and public disclosure of their 22 campaign finances. 23 (c) Any public officer or employee who breaches the 24 public trust for private gain and any person or entity 25 inducing such breach shall be liable to the state for all 26 financial benefits obtained by such actions. The manner of 27 recovery and additional damages may be provided by law. 28 (d) Any public officer or employee who is convicted of 29 a felony involving a breach of public trust shall be subject 30 to forfeiture of rights and privileges under a public 31

retirement system or pension plan in such manner as may be 1 2 provided by law. 3 (e) No member of the legislature or statewide elected 4 officer shall personally represent another person or entity 5 for compensation before the government body or agency of which the individual was an officer or member for a period of two 6 7 years following vacation of office. No member of the legislature shall personally represent another person or 8 9 entity for compensation during term of office before any state 10 agency other than judicial tribunals. Similar restrictions on 11 other public officers and employees may be established by law. 12 (f) Members of the legislative branch are subject to sanction for ethics violations as are all other officers and 13 14 employees subject to the code of ethics. (g)(f) There shall be an independent commission to 15 conduct investigations and make public reports on all 16 17 complaints concerning breach of public trust by public 18 officers or employees not within the jurisdiction of the judicial qualifications commission. 19 20 (h) (g) This section shall not be construed to limit 21 disclosures and prohibitions which may be established by law 22 to preserve the public trust and avoid conflicts between 23 public duties and private interests. (i) (h) Schedule--On the effective date of this 24 25 amendment and until changed by law: 26 (1) Full and public disclosure of financial interests 27 shall mean filing with the secretary of state by July 1 of 28 each year a sworn statement showing net worth and identifying 29 each asset and liability in excess of \$1,000 and its value 30 together with one of the following: 31

8	include disclosure of secondary sources of income.
