1 A proposal to revise 2 Article VI, s. 5, Fla. Const.; providing for 3 elections to be held on Saturday and Sunday and 4 prohibiting second primaries. 5 It is proposed by the Florida Constitution Revision Commission 6 7 that: 8 9 Section 1. Section 5 of Article VI of the Florida in 10 revised by amending that section to read: 11 ARTICLE VI 12 SUFFRAGE AND ELECTIONS 13 SECTION 5. General and special elections. -- A general 14 election shall be held in each county on the first Saturday 15 and Sunday Tuesday after the first Monday in November of each 16 even-numbered year to choose a successor to each elective 17 state and county officer whose term will expire before the 18 next general election and, except as provided herein, to fill 19 each vacancy in elective office for the unexpired portion of 20 the term. Only one primary election for the nomination of 21 candidates for political parties may be held prior to the 22 general election. A general election may be suspended or 23 delayed due to a state of emergency or impending emergency pursuant to general law. Special elections and referenda 24 25 shall be held as provided by law. 26 27
