Electors. -- Every citizen of the United States who is at least $\underline{\text{eighteen}}$ $\underline{\text{twenty-one}}$ years of age and 13 who is has been a permanent resident of for one year in the 14 15 state and six months in a county, if registered as provided by 16 law, shall be an elector of that county.
