Section 4 of Article VI of the State Constitution is amended to read:

## ARTICLE VI

## SUFFRAGE AND ELECTIONS

SECTION 4. Disqualifications.-

- (a) (1) Except as otherwise provided in paragraph (2), no person convicted of a felony, or adjudicated in this or any other state to be mentally incompetent, shall be qualified to vote or hold office until restoration of civil rights or removal of disability.
- (2) If convicted of a felony other than a felony involving a sexual offense or a felony involving a homicide, the person's civil rights shall be restored upon the person's completion of sentence, including parole or probation if applicable.
- (b) No person may appear on the ballot for re-election to any of the following offices:
  - (1) Florida representative,
  - (2) Florida senator,
  - (3) Florida Lieutenant governor,
  - (4) any office of the Florida cabinet,
  - (5) U.S. Representative from Florida, or
  - (6) U.S. Senator from Florida
