

Resolution of the Taxation and Budget Reform Commission
A resolution proposing the creation of a new section in
Article VII of the State Constitution to require the
Legislature to amend the laws of this state to permit
entry into an agreement with other states to simplify the
process by which remote sellers may calculate and remit
sales and use taxes to the state.

Be It Resolved by the Taxation and Budget Reform Commission:

That the following creation of a new section in Article VII
of the State Constitution is agreed to and shall be submitted to
the electors of this state for approval or rejection at the next
general election or at an earlier special election specifically
authorized by law for that purpose:

ARTICLE VII

FINANCE AND TAXATION

Agreement to facilitate collection of sales and use taxes
on remote sales.--The legislature shall amend the laws of this
state to permit entry into an agreement with other states to
simplify the process by which remote sellers may calculate and
remit sales and use taxes to the state.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following statement be
placed on the ballot:

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

ARTICLE VII

COLLECTION OF SALES AND USE TAXES ON REMOTE SALES.--This
proposed amendment to the State Constitution requires that the
Legislature amend the laws of the state to permit entry into an
agreement with other states to simplify the process by which
