Dear President Pruitt and Speaker Rubio:

The Taxation and Budget Reform Commission hereby submits the Committee Substitute for Statutory Recommendation 5 for consideration by the Florida Legislature.

Article XI, section 6 of the Florida Constitution requires the Commission to conduct a review and to "propose to the legislature any recommended statutory changes related to the taxation or budgetary laws of the state." Consistent with this duty, the Commission approved the Committee Substitute for Statutory Recommendation 5 by a vote of 17-0 on January 18, 2008.

The Committee Substitute for Statutory Recommendation 5 is the implementing legislation for the Committee Substitute for Constitutional Proposal 4. The constitutional proposal authorizes the Legislature to prohibit the consideration of storm-hardening improvements and the installation of renewable energy source devices in the determination of the assessed value of residential real property. The text and analysis of the recommendation are attached.
