Amendment to Amendment (Amendment No. 1)

Remove lines 170-174 and insert:

- (d)(1) A local government's revenue limitation for any fiscal year may be increased by up to three percent by a two-thirds vote, up to five percent by a three-fourths vote, and by more than five percent by a unanimous vote of the membership of the governing board of a local government in a separate ordinance that contains no other subject and that sets forth the dollar amount by which the local government revenues allowed will be increased or by approval of the ordinance by referendum.
- (2) The state revenue limitation may be increased for a period not to exceed ten years upon approval by a two-thirds vote of the membership of each house of the legislature.
