

1 Resolution of the Taxation and Budget Reform Commission
 2 A resolution proposing the creation of a new section in
 3 Article VII of the State Constitution to require the
 4 Legislature to amend the laws of this state to permit
 5 entry into an agreement with other states to simplify the
 6 process by which remote sellers may calculate and remit
 7 sales and use taxes to the state.

 9 Be It Resolved by the Taxation and Budget Reform Commission:

 11 That the following creation of a new section in Article VII
 12 of the State Constitution is agreed to and shall be submitted to
 13 the electors of this state for approval or rejection at the next
 14 general election or at an earlier special election specifically
 15 authorized by law for that purpose:

16 ARTICLE VII

17 FINANCE AND TAXATION

18 Agreement to facilitate collection of sales and use taxes
 19 on remote sales.--The legislature shall amend the laws of this
 20 state to permit entry into an agreement with other states to
 21 simplify the process by which remote sellers may calculate and
 22 remit sales and use taxes to the state. This section expires
 23 December 31, 2013.

 25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following statement be
 26 placed on the ballot:

27 CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

28 ARTICLE VII

29 COLLECTION OF SALES AND USE TAXES ON REMOTE SALES.--This
 30 proposed amendment to the State Constitution requires that the

31 Legislature amend the laws of the state to permit entry into an
32 agreement with other states to simplify the process by which
33 remote sellers may calculate and remit sales and use taxes to
34 the state.
