Amendment to Substitute Amendment (Amendment No. 8) (with ballot statement amendment)

On line 108 insert:

(10) not limit revenue growth associated with the ability of local governments to issue, repay and refund bonds for (i) acquisition of interests in environmentally sensitive property, (ii) development and redevelopment of infrastructure, (iii) public safety, public health and emergency services equipment and facilities, and (iv) essential governmental services.

Remove lines 128-136 and insert:

TAXPAYER PROTECTION AMENDMENT.--Requires the Legislature to limit state and local government revenues to reflect changes in population, or enrollment for school districts, and inflation. Implementing legislation must provide for: voter approval of new taxes; a supermajority vote of the Legislature or a local governing board to exceed a revenue limit; flexibility to fiscally distressed counties and municipalities; flexibility to fiscally responsible local governments; and an exception for revenues to repay certain local government bonds.
