

1 Resolution of the Taxation and Budget Reform Commission
 2 A resolution proposing the creation of a new Section 20 of
 3 Article III of the State Constitution to prohibit the
 4 enactment of laws affecting or impacting issues that are a
 5 mandatory subject of collective bargaining for public
 6 employees.

 8 Be It Resolved by the Taxation and Budget Reform Commission:

 10 That the following creation of Section 20 of Article III of
 11 the State Constitution is agreed to and shall be submitted to
 12 the electors of this state for approval or rejection at the next
 13 general election or at an earlier special election specifically
 14 authorized by law for that purpose:

15 ARTICLE III

16 LEGISLATURE

17 SECTION 20. Legislation of matters subject to collective
 18 bargaining by public employees.--No law affecting or impacting
 19 upon employment or a condition of employment of a public
 20 employee shall apply to a unit of local government to the extent
 21 the employee is represented by a labor organization and the
 22 subject of the law is a mandatory subject of collective
 23 bargaining. No law shall require binding arbitration or its
 24 equivalent between local government public employers and their
 25 employees.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following statement be
 27 placed on the ballot:

28 CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

29 ARTICLE III, SECTION 20

30 LEGISLATION OF MATTERS SUBJECT TO COLLECTIVE BARGAINING BY
31 PUBLIC EMPLOYEES.--This proposed amendment to the Florida
32 Constitution will prohibit the Legislature from enacting laws
33 that address issues that are mandatory subjects of collective
34 bargaining. The amendment will also prohibit laws requiring
35 binding arbitration between public employers and employees. Any
36 laws in conflict with the amendment will be invalidated.
