Resolution of the Taxation and Budget Reform Commission A resolution proposing the creation of Section 28 of Article X of the State Constitution to use thirty-five percent (35%) of the revenues from the excise tax on documents to fund the management, restoration, and acquisition of state lands.

Be It Resolved by the Taxation and Budget Reform Commission:

That the following creation of Section 28 of Article X of the State Constitution is agreed to and shall be submitted to the electors of this state for approval or rejection at the next general election or at an earlier special election specifically authorized by law for that purpose:

ARTICLE X

MISCELLANEOUS

- SECTION 28. Florida Land and Water Conservation Trust Fund.--
- (a) There is hereby established in the state treasury the Florida Land and Water Conservation Trust Fund, which shall not be subject to creation or termination under Section 19 of Article III.
- (b) Effective July 1, 2009, and continuing for 20 years thereafter, thirty-five percent (35%) of the proceeds of the revenues derived from the excise tax on documents shall, as collected, be placed monthly in the Florida Land and Water Conservation Trust Fund. The Florida Land and Water Conservation Trust Fund may also receive funds from any other source.

(c) Funds in the Florida Land and Water Conservation Trust
Fund shall be expended as provided by general law solely to
acquire, manage, and restore land and related property
interests, including those in the Florida Everglades, for use as
state parks, recreation areas, preserves, reserves, historic or
archaeological sites, geologic or botanical sites, recreational
trails, forests, water and wilderness areas, wildlife management
areas, urban and rural open space, and to retire Preservation
2000 and Florida Forever bonds, issued before July 1, 2009. The
funds in the Florida Land and Water Conservation Trust Fund, or
the income thereon, shall not be subject to assessment,
surcharge, appropriation, or other use.
(d) For the purposes of this section, the term, "excise
tax on documents" means the tax levied and collected under

- tax on documents" means the tax levied and collected under chapter 201, Florida Statutes, or any successor or replacement tax levied, collected and paid on documents that evidence a financial transaction.
 - (e) This section expires June 30, 2029.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following statement be placed on the ballot:

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

ARTICLE X, SECTION 28

FLORIDA LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION TRUST FUND. -Establishes the Florida Land and Water Conservation Trust Fund.
Limits use of the trust fund for specified land and water
conservation purposes involving the restoration, management, and
acquisition of land and related property interests and to retire
specified land conservation bonds. Provides funding for the
trust fund. Allocates 35 percent of the revenues from the
