SECTION 20. Legislative power to address a fiscal crisis.--

(a) Upon certification by the Governor that a serious fiscal crisis threatens the state, the legislature shall have the authority to adopt by three-fourths vote of both houses, such measures as may be necessary to raise revenue, notwithstanding any other provision of this constitution.

(b) Legislative acts authorized by this section shall expire two years from the date of the last certification of the existence of a serious fiscal crisis or earlier date specified by the legislature.

The amendment to Article III authorizing the legislature to adopt such measures as may be necessary to raise revenue during a serious fiscal crisis, and this section, shall take effect upon approval by the electors.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following statement be placed on the ballot:

## CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

## ARTICLE VII

LEGISLATIVE POWER TO ADDRESS A FISCAL CRISIS.—This proposed amendment to the State Constitution permits the Governor to certify that serious fiscal crisis threatens the state. Upon such certification, the Legislature may adopt by a three-fourths vote of both houses, such measures as may be necessary to raise revenue, notwithstanding other provisions of the State Constitution that limit the authority of the Legislature to raise revenue.
