ARTICLE XII

SCHEDULE

Minimum funding for the public education system; use of gambling revenues.—The amendment to Article IX requiring funding of the public education system from the general revenue fund in an amount at least equal to the national average funding per student and requiring certain gambling revenues to supplement that funding, and this section, shall first apply to school years commencing in state fiscal year 2012-2013.

ARTICLE XII

MININUM FUNDING OF THE PUBLIC EDUCATION SYSTEM AND USE OF GAMBLING REVENUES. -- Under this proposed amendment to the State Constitution, state funding of prekindergarten, kindergarten through grade 12, community college, undergraduate, and graduate levels of the public education system must be funded from the General Revenue Fund in an amount at least equal to the national average funding per student. This amendment also requires certain state gambling revenues to supplement the General Revenue funds.
