Amendment (with ballot statement amendment)

Remove line(s) 81-181 and insert:

SECTION 19. State and local long-term revenue limits.--

Revenue collected by a special district, municipality, county, or the state shall be limited to the revenue collected during the 2007-2008 fiscal year adjusted for the percentage change in inflation and population. The Legislature shall, by general law, implement this section, including defining "revenues," providing procedures to override the revenue limit, and providing procedures for the disposition of revenues in excess of the limit. The Legislature may also provide for a process to suspend a revenue limit for up to four years by referendum.

STATE AND LOCAL LONG-TERM REVENUE LIMITS.--This proposed amendment to the State Constitution limits revenues for special districts, municipalities, counties, and the state to the revenues collected in the 2007-2008 fiscal year adjusted for the percentage change in inflation and population. Legislation to implement the amendment may address issues including: the definition of "revenues," procedures for the disposition of excess revenues, and a process to suspend a revenue limit.
