It was stipulated at the hearing that this matter would be maintained confidential pending the Referee's Report and subsequent Order of the Court.

Respondent withdrew his Motion to Dismiss.

A stipulation of facts was entered into and filed before this II. Referee by The Florida Bar and the Respondent. The Referee accepts the stipulation and adopts the same as the Finding of Fact in this cause.

Counsel for The Florida Bar stated during the hearing that Respondent's acts did not constitute dishonesty, fraud or deceit as set forth in Disciplinary Rule 1-102 (A)(4); but were more properly a violation of standards under Integration Rule 11.02 (3)(a) of Article XI.

- I recommend that the Respondent be found guilty of violating Integration Rule 11.02 (3)(a), Article XI, Integration Rules of The Florida Bar. I further recommend that Respondent III. be found guilty of violating Disciplinary Rules 2-106 (B) and 7-101 (A)(3) of The Florida Bar's Code of Professional Responsibility.
- IV. I recommend that Respondent receive a public reprimand and that he pay costs incurred by The Florida Bar in this cause.
