## DISCRETIONARY REVIEW OF DECISION OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF APPEAL, SECOND DISTRICT OF FLORIDA

### BRIEF OF RESPONDENT ON JURISDICTION

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### ISSUE

WHETHER THE OPINION OF THE SECOND DISTRICT COURT OF APPEAL WHICH DENIES CERTIORARI, AND EXPRESSLY DECLARES VALID SECTION 856.021, FLORIDA STATUTES, WARRANTS DIS-CRETIONARY REVIEW BY THIS COURT.

Petitioner, Nelson Watts, seeks to have this Court review the decision of the Second District Court of Appeal which expressly declared valid Section 856.021, Florida Statutes. Essentially, Petitioner seeks to have this Court revisit and reverse its opinion in <u>State v. Ecker</u>, 311 So.2d 104 (Fla. 1975), <u>cert</u>. <u>denied</u>, 423 U.S. 1019, 96 S.Ct. 455, 46 L.Ed.2d 391 (1975), which upheld the validity of Section 856.021.

In support of its argument that this Court should again address the validity of Section 856.021, Florida Statutes, Petitioner relies on the decision of the United States Supreme Court in <u>Kolender v. Lawson</u>, \_\_U.S.\_\_, 75 L.Ed.2d 903, 103 S.Ct. \_\_ (1983). The Second District Court of Appeal was asked to analyze the instant case in light of <u>Kolender</u> and opined "while some of the authorities and reasoning relied upon in <u>Ecker</u> have now been disapproved in <u>Kolender</u>, we feel that Section 856.021 is so much more definitive than the California Statute was to render the result in <u>Ecker</u> still valid." <u>Watts</u> <u>v. State</u>, \_\_So.2d\_\_, 8 F.L.W. 2796 (Fla. 2 DCA, Opinion filed November 23, 1983). No further review is warranted.

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#### CONCLUSION

Respondent, State of Florida, respectfully requests that this Court decline to accept jurisdiction to redetermine the validity of Section 856.021, Florida Statutes.
