Florida Public Service Commission</u>, 440 So.2d 371 (Fla. 1st DCA 1983), on the basis of conflict with <u>Citizens v. Hawkins</u>, 364 So.2d 723 (Fla. 1978). After hearing oral argument, however, we find no express and direct conflict between these cases and, consequently, no basis for this Court to accept jurisdiction in this cause.
