Petitioner, Michael C. Norvell, pro se, pursuant to Integration Rule 11.08 hereby submits his Petition For Leave To Resign and in support thereof says:

1. Petitioner is a member of the Florida Bar and his number is 20229.

2. Petitioner was convicted in the United States District Court for the Middle District of Florida in January, 1983 on a charge of Conspiracy To Possess And Distribute Marijuana. The Petitioner was sentenced to five (5) years imprisonment and is currently incarcerated at the Federal Correctional Institution, Lexington, Kentucky.


3. Petitioner's license to practice law in the State of Florida is currently under suspension by order of this court as a result of that conviction.

4. Petitioner is the accused attorney in Florida Bar Disciplinary Proceeding Case No. 05B84C27 as a result of said conviction and this court's suspension.

5. Petitioner does not desire to oppose the disciplinary proceedings of the Florida Bar as he is not in a position to dispute the allegations contained therein at this time.

6. Petitioner desires to resign from the Florida Bar with the provision that he not be eligible to apply for readmission for a period of four years from the date of the granting of this Petition For Leave To Resign.


