This case is before the Court pursuant to jurisdiction granted in article V, section 3(b)(4), Florida Constitution, because of a question certified as being of great public importance. <u>Donner v. Edelstein</u>, 450 So.2d 562 (Fla. 3d DCA 1984). This same question was certified to this Court in <u>Miami</u> <u>Herald Publishing Co. v. City of North Miami</u>, 452 So.2d 572 (Fla. 3d DCA 1983) and answered in the negative in <u>City of North Miami</u> <u>v. Miami Herald Publishing Co.</u>, No. 64,944 (Fla. Mar. 28, 1985).

Accordingly, the decision of the district court is approved.
