RESPONSE OF THE FLORIDA BAR TO THE PETITION OF  
RICHARD J. BORECKY FOR LEAVE TO RESIGN  
PENDING DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS

COMES NOW THE FLORIDA BAR, and files its response to the  
Petition of Richard J. Borecky for Leave to Resign Pending  
Disciplinary Proceedings and states as follows:

1. That on or about June 20, 1984, Richard J. Borecky  
executed a Petition for Leave to Resign Pending Disciplinary  
Proceedings, an executed copy of which has previously been  
forwarded to this Honorable Court.

2. That upon the filing of the Joint Motion of The Florida  
Bar and Richard J. Borecky, the Honorable Linda L. Vitale, Referee,  
entered an Order Staying Disciplinary Proceedings Pending Review  
by the Supreme Court of Florida of Respondent's Petition for  
Leave to Resign Pending Disciplinary Proceedings, the original  
which has been previously been forwarded to this Honorable Court.

3. That on or about July 20, 1984, the Board of Governors  
of The Florida Bar considered Mr. Borecky's Petition and voted  
its recommendation that this Honorable Court approve same.


4. That should this Honorable Court approve Mr. Borecky's Petition, the public interest would not be adversely affected.

5. That should this Honorable Court approve Mr. Borecky's Petition, neither the purity of the Courts nor the public's confidence in the legal profession would be adversely affected.

6. That consistent with the terms of Mr. Borecky's Petition for Leave to Resign Pending Disciplinary Proceedings, the Board of Governors recommends that this Honorable Court condition its approval of same upon the terms and representations incorporated in paragraphs 17 and 18 of the Petition for Resignation.

WHEREFORE, THE FLORIDA BAR respectfully requests this Honorable Court approve the Petition of Richard J. Borecky and that an appropriate Order would be entered granting him leave to resign, consistent with the terms and conditions discussed above.


