- Findings of Fact as to Each Item of Misconduct of Which the Respondent is Charged: After considering all the pleadings and evidence before me, I find the respondent guilty as to II. each act of misconduct alleged in the Complaint attached hereto.
- Recommendation as to Whether or not the Respondent Should Be Found Guilty: I recommend that the respondent be found guilty of the following violations of the Code of Professional III. Responsibility: That Richard D. Hamrick has violated Disciplinary Rules, DR 6-101(A)(3) (neglect of a legal matter); and DR 7-101(A)(1) (failure to seek the lawful objectives of the client).
 - Recommendation as to Disciplinary Measures to be Applied: I recommend that the respondent receive a Public Reprimand IV. and be assessed the costs of these proceedings.
