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## ARGUMENT

AN INFORMATION WHICH ALLEGES, IN THE ALTERNATIVE, A FELONY OR A MISDEMEA-NOR, IS INSUFFICIENT TO INVOKE THE JURISDICTION OF THE CIRCUIT COURT.

Petitioner is aware of this Court's recent decision in <u>State v. Phillips</u>, 10 FLW 110 (Fla. February 7, 1985), which lends support to the State's position. The Court, however, specifically limited its decision to the facts of that case. Additionally, the body of the information in the instant case, unlike that in <u>Phillips</u>, was contradictory in that it charged a felony or a misdemeanor in the alternative. This Court should not extend <u>Phillips</u> to the defect in the Petitioner's information.

#### CONCLUSION

BASED UPON the arguments and authorities presented herein and in the Petitioner's Initial Brief on the Merits, the Petitioner respectfully requests that this Honorable Court reverse the decision of the Fifth District Court of Appeal of the State of Florida.
