TO RESIGN PERMANENTLY OF SIDNEY C. WOOD


THE FLORIDA BAR, through undersigned counsel, hereby files its Response to the Petition for Leave to Resign Permanently Without Leave to Reapply, and states:

1. The Board of Governors of The Florida Bar at its September 18 - 21, 1985 meeting voted to approve Mr. Wood's Petition for Leave to Resign Permanently Without Leave to Reapply.

2. The Florida Bar requests that Mr. Wood's Petition for Permanent Resignation be ruled on in an expedited manner due to the nature of the allegations.

WHEREFORE, The Florida Bar requests that the Petition for Leave to Resign Permanently Without Leave to Reapply of Sidney C. Wood be granted immediately and that Mr. Wood be ordered to pay The Florida Bar costs incurred in the amount of \$2,308.72.


