

REPORT OF REFEREE

I. <u>Summary of Proceedings</u>: Pursuant to the undersigned being duly appointed as referee to conduct disciplinary proceedings herein according to article XI of the Integration Rule of The Florida Bar and Rule 3-7.5 Rules of Discipline, a final hearing was held on final hearing January 23,1987 and April 16, 1987.
