We have for review the consolidated cases of <u>Florida</u> <u>Patient's Compensation Fund v. Coxon</u> and <u>St. Joseph's Hospital,</u> <u>Inc. v. Coxon</u>, 502 So.2d 1369 (Fla. 2d DCA 1987), which are certified to be in direct conflict with <u>Bouchoc v. Peterson</u>, 490 So.2d 132 (Fla. 3d DCA 1986). Our jurisdiction is predicated upon article V, section 3(b)(4), of the Florida Constitution. We quash the decision of the district court of appeal and remand for disposition consistent with our recent decision in <u>Florida</u> <u>Patient's Compensation Fund v. Bouchoc</u>, Nos. 69,230, 69,493 and 69,421 (Fla. July 16, 1987).

It is so ordered.
