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# STATEMENT OF THE CASE AND FACTS

## SUMMARY OF THE ARGUMENT

The decision of the district court in <u>Mendez v. State</u>, Fla. 4th DCa Case No. 4-86-1210, Nov. 16, 1988, cites as controlling authority a decision that is pending review in this Court, in Case No. 73, 289. That case certified a question of great public importance. <u>State v. Avery</u>, 13 F.L.W. 1816 (Fla. 4th DCA August 3, 1988). This Court has jurisdiction to review this case under Article V, Section 3(b)(4) of the Florida Constitution.

#### **ISSUE**

THIS COURT HAS JURISDICTION TO REVIEW THE DECISION IN PETITIONER'S CASE BECAUSE THE DISTRICT COURT CITED AS AUTHORITY A DECISION THAT IS PENDING REVIEW IN THIS COURT

#### **ARGUMENT**

Respondent argees with Petitioner that jurisdiction properly lies in this Court since the District Court cited as controlling authority a case which is pending review in this Court. Jollie v. State, 405 So.2d 418 (Fla. 1981).

Respondent asserts, however, that in the interest of judicial economy this case should travel with Avery v. State, Case No. 73,289. The District Court has already determined that the fact situation <u>sub judice</u> falls within the ambit of <u>State v. Avery</u>, <u>supra</u>. Accordingly, no merit briefs need to be filed in the instant case as the merit briefs in <u>Avery v. State will</u> control the result of review in this case.

#### CONCLUSION

Wherefore, Respondent respectfully requests that this Court accept jurisdiction in this case, consolidate this case with Avery v. State, Case No. 73,289, and allow the merit briefs in Avery v. State to be considered as the merits briefs in the instant case.
