PER CURIAM.

We have for review <u>Hartland v. Allstate Insurance Co.</u>, 575 So.2d 290 (Fla. 1st DCA 1991), because of conflict with <u>Jernigan v. Progressive American Insurance Co.</u>, 501 So.2d 748 (Fla. 5th DCA), <u>review denied</u>, 513 So.2d 1062 (Fla. 1987). We have jurisdiction pursuant to article V, section 3(b)(3), Florida Constitution.

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We recently addressed the same issue which this case presents. <u>Brixius v. Allstate Ins. Co.</u>, 589 So.2d 236 (Fla. 1991). In <u>Brixius</u>, we approved the district court's decision which denied uninsured motorist benefits under very similar circumstances, and we disapproved the decision in <u>Jernigan</u>. Accordingly, the district court's decision in this case is approved.

It is so ordered.
