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STATEMENT OF THE CASE AND STATEMENT OF THE FACTS

Respondent's Statement of the Case and the Facts notes to this Court that there is an inconsistency in the Petitioner's Statement of the Case and the Facts regarding which physician initially saw Gretel Loeb at the Safecare HMO.
