Petition to Amend Bar Rules to be Filed January 31, 1992 - Proposed Rule 4.7.2(n)

Gentlemen:

I am commenting on proposed Rule 4-7.2(n).

I recommend an addition to subparagraph (3) of 4-7.2(n). This would allow a lawyer to state his or her educational background, such as institutions attended, and date, and nature of degree received. I suggest the following wording:

(3) technical and professional licenses granted by the state or other recognized licensing authorities, and educational institutions attended, including dates and nature of degrees received;

I believe this is factual information similar to the other information allowed under subparagraphs (1) through (8) of Rule 4-7.2(n) and would be useful to members of the public and other lawyers.

I also support the proposed change in subparagraph (5) of Rule 4-7.2(n) relating to fields of law in which the lawyer practices. Many lawyers practice in areas that are neither certified or designated by the Florida Bar. It is a real service to the public and other lawyers for a lawyer to be able to provide information about the areas in which he or she practices, even though it may not be an area subject to certification or designation.
