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SUMMARY OF THE ARGUMENT

In the instant case, the Second District Court affirmed the decision of the trial court, citing State v. Tripp, 591 So.2d 1055 (Fla. 2d DCA 1991), review of certified question pending, Tripp v. State, No.79,176. Since review currently is pending before this Court in Tripp, this Court has discretionary jurisdiction to accept review of the P.C.A. decision controlled by the cited authority.

ARGUMENT

ISSUE

WHETHER THIS COURT SHOULD EXERCISE ITS DISCRETIONARY JURISDICTION TO REVIEW THE INSTANT CASE.

In the instant case, the Second District Court issued a "citation P.C.A". In so doing, the Second District affirmed the decision of the trial court, citing State v. Tripp, 591 So.2d 1055 (Fla. 2d DCA 1991), review of certified question pending, Tripp v. State, No.79,176.

In <u>Jollie v. State</u>, 405 So.2d 418 (Fla. 1981), this Court held that a per curium decision without opinion which cites as controlling authority a decision that is pending review in this Court constitutes prima facie express conflict for purposes of jurisdiction. Accord, State v. Lofton, 534 So.2d 1148 (Fla. 1988). Thus, according to <u>Jollie</u> and <u>Lofton</u>, this Court has jurisdiction to review the decision in this case pursuant to Article V, section 3(b)(3), Florida Constitution.

CONCLUSION

Respondent respectfully requests that this Honorable Court affirm the judgment and sentence of the trial court.
