RESPONSE OF EMANUEL N. FEIGIN

COMES now the Respondent, Emanuel N. Feigin, a respec-
ter of our judicial system, who files this response under the
provisions of the Rules of Court and Article I, Section 21
of the Florida Constitution, submits this following response
to amendments of the CODE OF JUDICIAL CONDUCT:

1. The undersigned, supports all of the proposed changes
submitted by the Committee on Standards of Conduct Governing
Judges. The undersigned supports all changes and would respec-
tfully submit the following exceptions to the proposed amendments:

2. Proposed change to Canon 3(D)(2) Disciplinary Responsi-
bilities - suggests that the judge exercise a discretionary duty
on reporting an attorney to the Florida Bar for disciplinary
review and proceedings. The amendment should be modified by
substituting the word 'SHOULD' by the word 'SHALL'. This will
make it mandatory for a judge to report the attorney to the
Florida Bar for corrective action.

3; Proposed change to Canon 3(E)(1), Disqualification, which
rule allows the judge to continue in a proceeding whereby a
litigant and/or their representative(S) moves to disqualify
a judge for reasons stated. To allay fear and resentment the
proposed amendment should use the word 'SHALL in place of 'Should'.

4- The undersigned supports these changes as another way
to build and maintain confidence in the fairness of our system.


