Dear Justice Barkett:

The Florida Supreme Court Committee on Mediation and Arbitration Training has discussed the issue of senior retired judges acting as mediators and judges contemporaneously. We feel that doing **so** presents a conflict of interest and recommend to the court that this practice be prohibited. As an alternative, we suggest that the practice at least be prohibited in any circuit where the senior judge accepts assignment as a retired judge.

The Committee also recommends that the Supreme Court require that in every case the parties have the right to select their own mediator and the trial court not select the mediator unless the parties cannot agree on the selection.
