We have for review a decision on the following question certified to be of great public importance:

IS THE BUYER OF RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY
PREVENTED BY THE "ECONOMIC LOSS RULE" FROM
RECOVERING DAMAGES FOR FRAUD IN THE
INDUCEMENT AGAINST THE REAL ESTATE AGENT AND
ITS INDIVIDUAL AGENT REPRESENTING THE
SELLERS?

Woodson v. Martin, 663 So. 2d 1327 (Fla. 2d DCA 1995). We have jurisdiction. Art. V, § 3(b)(4), Fla. Const.

Our decision in <u>HTP, Ltd. v. Lineas Aereas Costarricenses</u>, <u>S.A.</u>, No. 86,913 (Fla. Oct. 17, 1996), controls. We answer the certified question in the negative, quash <u>Woodson</u>, and remand for proceedings consistent with <u>HTP</u>.

It is so ordered.
