#### REPLY

ISSUE:

WHETHER THE FAILURE OF THE TRIAL COURT TO ORALLY PRONOUNCE EACH STATUTORILY AUTHORIZED COST INDIVIDUALLY AT THE TIME OF SENTENCING CONSTITUTES FUNDAMENTAL ERROR

The answer brief filed by Respondent herein comprises two parts: a duplication of the district court's opinion herein (Answer Brief, pps. 6-12); and an argument against the right to appeal fundamental sentencing errors (Answer Brief, pps. 12-15). In response, Petitioner argues that, particularly with respect to discretionary costs and fees, the failure to give a criminal defendant notice and an opportunity to be heard violates state and federal constitutional principles of due process, and is thus fundamental error, addressable for the first time on direct appeal.

#### CONCLUSION

Based on the facts of this case, the rules and statutes cited, the constitutional principles, case law and legal argument presented, petitioner respectfully requests that this Court answer the certified question in the affirmative, disapprove of the decision of the First District Court of Appeal, and remand this case to that court for further consideration.
