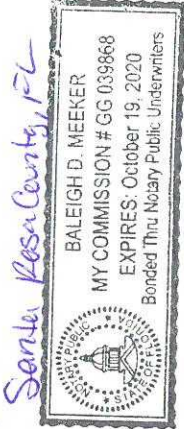

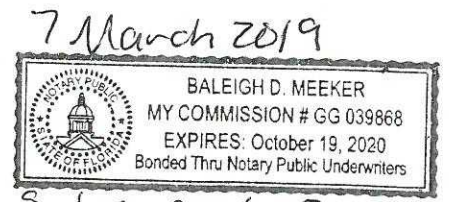
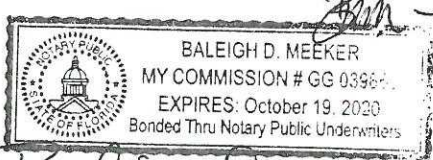

ORDER APPOINTING EXPERT FOR COMPETENCY EVALUATION

THIS CAUSE came before the Court pursuant to 916.115, *Florida Statutes*, and on the State's Motion To Appoint Expert for Competency Evaluation and Certificate of Good Faith, the Court being duly advised in the premises and based on the proceedings before the Court, it is hereby

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:**

1. All proceedings in this case are now stayed, pending further order of this Court. The Court appoints Dr. Benson.

2. The expert shall consider the following issues each of which shall be specifically addressed in the report:

A. Whether Defendant is competent to stand trial pursuant to the criteria set forth in Chapter 916, *Florida Statutes*, and applicable *Florida Rules of Criminal Procedure*, and in determining and reporting relative to Defendant's competency to stand trial, said expert shall address and evaluate Defendant's mental capacity, and understanding relative to the following factors:

- 1) Defendant's appreciation of charges;
- 2) Defendant's appreciation of range and nature of possible penalties;
- 3) Defendant's understanding of the adversary nature of the legal process;

- 4) Defendant's capacity to disclose to attorney pertinent facts surrounding the alleged offense;
- 5) Defendant's ability to relate to attorney;
- 6) Defendant's ability to assist attorney in planning defense;
- 7) Defendant's capacity to realistically challenge prosecution witnesses;
- 8) Defendant's ability to manifest appropriate courtroom behavior;
- 9) Defendant's capacity to testify relevantly;
- 10) Defendant's motivation to help self in legal process;
- 11) Defendant's capacity to cope with the stress of incarceration prior to trial.

B. If it is determined that Defendant is not competent to stand trial, the expert shall further examine and report concerning Defendant's meeting the criteria for involuntary hospitalization set forth in Chapter 394, *Florida Statutes*, or involuntary admission to residential services pursuant to Chapter 393, *Florida Statutes*, and in determining the issue of involuntary hospitalization, the examining expert shall consider and include in his/her report an analysis of the following factors:

- 1) The nature and extent of the mental illness or mental retardation suffered by the Defendant;
- 2) Whether Defendant, because of such mental illness or mental retardation, meets the criteria for involuntary hospitalization or placement set forth by law;
- 3) Whether there is a substantial probability that Defendant will attain competence to stand trial within the foreseeable future;
- 4) The nature of the care and treatment to be afforded Defendant and its probable duration;
- 5) Alternatives other than involuntary hospitalization which might be less restrictive on the Defendant's liberty.

C. **THIS EVALUATION IS SOLELY ON THE ISSUE OF COMPETENCY. THE EXPERT APPOINTED SHALL NOT CONDUCT ANY EVALUATION ON THE STATUS OF THE DEFENDANT'S SANITY AT THE TIME OF THE ALLEGED OFFENSE.**

3. Said examination shall be conducted at the County Jail if the defendant is incarcerated unless otherwise ordered by the Court.
4. If Defendant is not incarcerated, defense counsel is hereby directed to make the necessary appointments with the expert and to advise Defendant of the time and place thereof.
5. The expert named in this order shall submit the report to the Court no later than the 28 day of March, 2019 with a copy of the report to the defendant's attorney and the Office of the State Attorney.
6. The Court determines for purposes of this order only that:


**Pursuant to Administrative Order No. 2017-32, the expert shall be appointed from the First Judicial Circuit Court Appointed Expert Witness Registry**

Any excess of the rates as outlined in AO2017-32 will require an appropriate motion and order of this court prior to any service rendered in excess of this order.

Court Administration for the First Judicial Circuit shall be responsible from its allotted budget for the payment of the appointed expert for the **examination and report ONLY** and solely on the issue of competency to proceed. When the expert has completed his or her evaluation of the defendant's competency to proceed under this court order and filed the evaluation report, the expert's service to the court is complete.

If the expert appointed herein also addresses issues related to sanity as an affirmative defense, the court shall pay only for that portion of the expert's fees relating to the evaluation on competency to proceed, and the balance of the fees shall be chargeable to the defense.

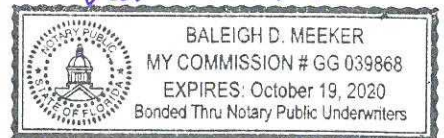
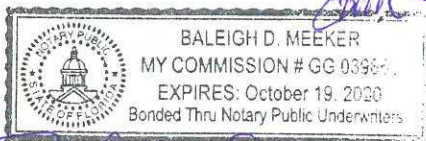

ORDER APPOINTING EXPERT FOR COMPETENCY EVALUATION

THIS CAUSE came before the Court pursuant to 916.115, *Florida Statutes*, and on the State's Motion To Appoint Expert for Competency Evaluation and Certificate of Good Faith, the Court being duly advised in the premises and based on the proceedings before the Court, it is hereby

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

1. All proceedings in this case are now stayed, pending further order of this Court. The Court appoints Dr. Benson.
2. The expert shall consider the following issues each of which shall be specifically addressed in the report:
  - A. Whether Defendant is competent to stand trial pursuant to the criteria set forth in Chapter 916, *Florida Statutes*, and applicable *Florida Rules of Criminal Procedure*, and in determining and reporting relative to Defendant's competency to stand trial, said expert shall address and evaluate Defendant's mental capacity, and understanding relative to the following factors:
    - 1) Defendant's appreciation of charges;
    - 2) Defendant's appreciation of range and nature of possible penalties;
    - 3) Defendant's understanding of the adversary nature of the legal process;

- 4) Defendant's capacity to disclose to attorney pertinent facts surrounding the alleged offense;
  - 5) Defendant's ability to relate to attorney;
  - 6) Defendant's ability to assist attorney in planning defense;
  - 7) Defendant's capacity to realistically challenge prosecution witnesses;
  - 8) Defendant's ability to manifest appropriate courtroom behavior;
  - 9) Defendant's capacity to testify relevantly;
  - 10) Defendant's motivation to help self in legal process;
  - 11) Defendant's capacity to cope with the stress of incarceration prior to trial.
- B. If it is determined that Defendant is not competent to stand trial, the expert shall further examine and report concerning Defendant's meeting the criteria for involuntary hospitalization set forth in Chapter 394, *Florida Statutes*, or involuntary admission to residential services pursuant to Chapter 393, *Florida Statutes*, and in determining the issue of involuntary hospitalization, the examining expert shall consider and include in his/her report an analysis of the following factors:
- 1) The nature and extent of the mental illness or mental retardation suffered by the Defendant;
  - 2) Whether Defendant, because of such mental illness or mental retardation, meets the criteria for involuntary hospitalization or placement set forth by law;
  - 3) Whether there is a substantial probability that Defendant will attain competence to stand trial within the foreseeable future;
  - 4) The nature of the care and treatment to be afforded Defendant and its probable duration;
  - 5) Alternatives other than involuntary hospitalization which might be less restrictive on the Defendant's liberty.

C. **THIS EVALUATION IS SOLELY ON THE ISSUE OF COMPETENCY. THE EXPERT APPOINTED SHALL NOT CONDUCT ANY EVALUATION ON THE STATUS OF THE DEFENDANT'S SANITY AT THE TIME OF THE ALLEGED OFFENSE.**

- 3. Said examination shall be conducted at the County Jail if the defendant is incarcerated unless otherwise ordered by the Court.
- 4. If Defendant is not incarcerated, defense counsel is hereby directed to make the necessary appointments with the expert and to advise Defendant of the time and place thereof.
- 5. The expert named in this order shall submit the report to the Court no later than the 28 day of March, 2019 with a copy of the report to the defendant's attorney and the Office of the State Attorney.
- 6. The Court determines for purposes of this order only that:

Pursuant to Administrative Order No. 2017-32, the expert shall be appointed from the First Judicial Circuit Court Appointed Expert Witness Registry

Any excess of the rates as outlined in AO2017-32 will require an appropriate motion and order of this court prior to any service rendered in excess of this order.

Court Administration for the First Judicial Circuit shall be responsible from its allotted budget for the payment of the appointed expert for the examination and report ONLY and solely on the issue of competency to proceed. When the expert has completed his or her evaluation of the defendant's competency to proceed under this court order and filed the evaluation report, the expert's service to the court is complete.

If the expert appointed herein also addresses issues related to sanity as an affirmative defense, the court shall pay only for that portion of the expert's fees relating to the evaluation on competency to proceed, and the balance of the fees shall be chargeable to the defense.
