**PLAINTIFFS' MOTION TO COMPEL DEFENDANT WETZEL TO ABIDE BY COURT
ORDER**

COME NOW, Plaintiffs, THE TRAVELERS COMPANIES, INC. F/K/A ST. PAUL
FIRE AND MARINE INSURANCE COMPANY and ST. PAUL TRAVELERS COMPANIES,
INC. ("Plaintiffs"), by and through the undersigned counsel, and hereby files their Motion to
Compel Defendant to Abide by Court Order executed June 27, 2016 pursuant to Fla. R. Civ. Proc
1.560(b) requiring Defendant to complete form 1.977 including all required attachments, and in
support states as follows.

1. On October 10, 2014 Plaintiff filed its Amended Motion Attorney's Fees and
Costs ("Motion for Fees and Costs").
2. The Motion for Fees and Costs followed the Court's December 15, 2014 Order
Granting Plaintiffs' Motion for Summary Judgment. Accordingly, the Court granted Plaintiffs'
Motion for Summary Judgment and expressly ruled that "Plaintiffs are entitled to judgment as a
matter of law on Count I (Fraud) and Count II (Injunctive Relief) of the Complaint". The Court

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retained jurisdiction to issue a ruling with respect to Plaintiff's application for fees and costs.

3. Subsequently, a Final Judgment Awarding Attorney's fees and Costs was executed by the Honorable John L. Miller on June 27, 2016.

4. The Court awarded Plaintiff reasonable attorneys and paralegal fees of \$57,947.41 which sum shall bear interest at the statutory rate of 4.68% per year, for all of which let execution issue forthwith. (See Attached Exhibit A at Paragraph 3).

4. The court specifically retained jurisdiction to "enter further orders that are proper to compel the judgment debtor, defendant Larry Wetzel, to complete form 1.977, including all required attachments, and serve it on the judgment creditor's (Plaintiffs') attorney".

5. To date, the undersigned attorney firm has not received this court ordered information, specifically the form 1.977, a copy of which is attached hereto as exhibit B.

6. Florida Rule of Civil Procedure 1.560(b) allows the court, at the request of the judgment creditor to order the judgment debtor to complete form 1.977 including all attachments within forty five (45) days of the Order or other such time as deemed by the court. The Rule goes on to state that "failure to obey the order may be considered contempt of court." Fla. R. Civ. Pro. 1.560(b).

7. At this time, nearly six months after the Final Judgment Awarding Attorneys' Fees was executed June 27, 2016, Defendant Wetzel has not provided this information to the undersigned.

8. Considering that this honorable Court found in its Order Granting Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Final Judgment that, "[Defendant's] fictitious judgment had no basis in law or in fact as there was no sixteen million dollar (\$16,000,000.00) judgment as all lawsuits

initiated by Wetzel in that jurisdiction have been dismissed" Mr. Wetzel should be held in contempt for failure to abide by the June 27, 2016 Court Order.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff respectfully requests that this Court compel Defendant Wetzel to abide by its June 27, 2016 court order, deem Mr. Wetzel in contempt of court, and for sanctions, or for all such relief as the Court finds just and proper.

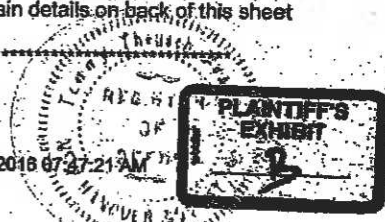

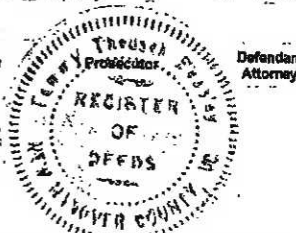

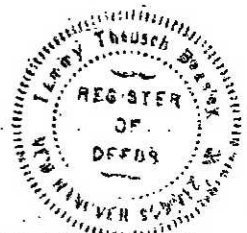

Orders Exceeding Jurisdiction

An order that exceeds the jurisdiction of the court is void, and can be attacked in any proceeding in any court where the validity of the judgment comes into issue. (See *Rose v. Himely* (1808) 4 Cranch 241, 2 L ed 608; *Pennoyer v. Neff* (1877) 95 US 714, 24 L ed 665; *Thompson v. Whitman* (1873) 18 Wall 467, 21 L ed 897; *Windsor v. McVeigh* (1876) 93 US 274, 23 L ed 914; *McDonald v. Mabee* (1917) 243 US 90, 37 Sct 343, 61 L ed 608.

"If a court grants relief, which under the circumstances it hasn't any authority to grant, its judgment is to that extent void." (1 Freeman on Judgments, 120c.) "A void judgment is no judgment at all and is without legal effect." (*Jordon v. Gilligan*, 500 F.2d 701, 710 (6th Cir. 1974) "a court must vacate any judgment entered in excess of its jurisdiction." (*Lubben v. Selective Service System Local Bd. No. 27*, 463 F.2d 646 (1st Cir. 1972).

A void judgment does not create any binding obligation. Federal decisions addressing void state court judgments include *Kalib v. Feuerstein* (1940) 308 US 433, 60 S Ct 343, 84 L ed 370. Federal judges issued orders permanently barring Stich from filing any papers in federal courts. After Judges Robert Jones and Edward Jellen corruptly seized and started to liquidate Stich's assets, Judge Jones issued an unconstitutional order barring Stich from filing any objection to the seizure and liquidation.

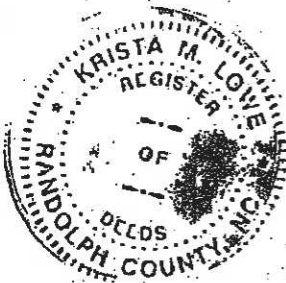

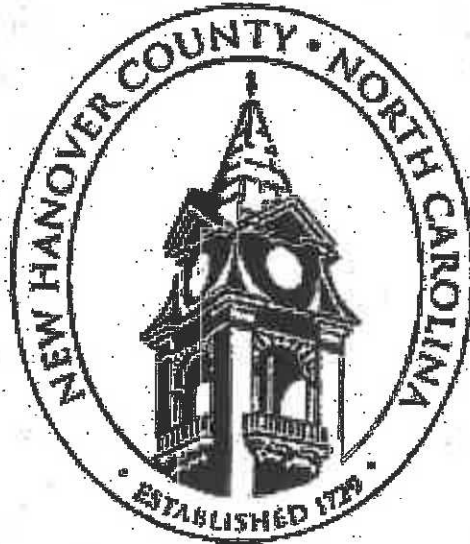

To Whom It May Concern ,

We write to request that Larry Wetzel, an American Citizen who has been unjustly detained in Santa Rosa County Jail of Florida, be granted a 'habeas corpus' and immediately released/ returned to either Georgia/ Arizona the places of his latest residencies or the Texas airport where he was arrested on a Fraud warrant without being indicted for a crime in Florida.

Larry Wetzel has worked peacefully in Georgia/Arizona since 2014. There appears to be no evidence to substantiate the allegation of Fraud other than an unsubstantiated allegation in the Civil Court of Santa Rosa County Florida by a supposedly Plaintiff, Christopher Duffy, in Illinois without an affidavit of said allegation. Moreover, the same authorities have repeatedly denied regular and appropriate 'access to the courts' by 'Pro Se' litigants in the Santa Rosa County jail.

Larry Wetzel's unlawful imprisonment has been raised repeatedly by his family and with affidavits presenting evidence he is being detained against his Consent and without Lawful Authority by the authorities in Santa Rosa County Florida and the Florida Supreme Court. Unfortunately, efforts to secure Larry Wetzel's release have been unsuccessful. We are deeply disappointed in the officials disallowing a citizen's right to file a 'Habeas Corpus' in violation of 'due process', with and by the County Courts publishing undocumented rulings of the Florida Supreme Court and those orders being used in violation of the Florida Constitution provision, 'Access to the Courts' by the Courty Officials including the Sheriffs in Santa Rosa County Florida denying 'Pro Se' litigants filings / Habeas Corpus.

We hope that the Santa Rosa Sheriff will reevaluate the situation in the light of now knowing Larry Wetzel was not a fugitive from justice in that he had not been indicted by a Grand Jury, nor convicted of a Felony in Florida and therefore he was kidnapped in Texas at the airport and brought to Florida on a bogus warrant.

In the spirit of 'due process', we respectfully ask you to consider Larry Wetzel's case and respond to how the recent treatment of him, by hand cuffing and putting him in a dog pen to transport from Texas to Florida jail, places significant strain not only on him and his family, but also on the bilateral relationship between the United States and
