<b>Rule</b>	<b>Reasons for Amendments</b>
9.120 (Discretionary Proceedings to Review Decisions of District Courts of Appeal)	<p>Corrects reference to the Supreme Court by adding “supreme”.</p> <p>Subdivision (e) amended to shorten the timeframe for transmission of the record on appeal from 60 days to 25 days after jurisdiction is accepted. Amends subdivision (g) to expand the period within which to serve the initial brief on the merits from 20 days to 35 days after the Supreme Court accepts jurisdiction.</p>
9.210 (Briefs)	<p>Amends subdivision (a) to detail that page limits for computer-generated petitions, responses, and replies are converted to word counts. Page limits are retained only for briefs that are handwritten or typewritten.</p> <p>Amends subdivision (a) to remove superfluous language. Amends subdivision (b) to remove references to page limits for the summary of argument and conclusion sections.</p> <p>Adopts a Committee Note explaining the word count limits for computer-generated briefs.</p>
