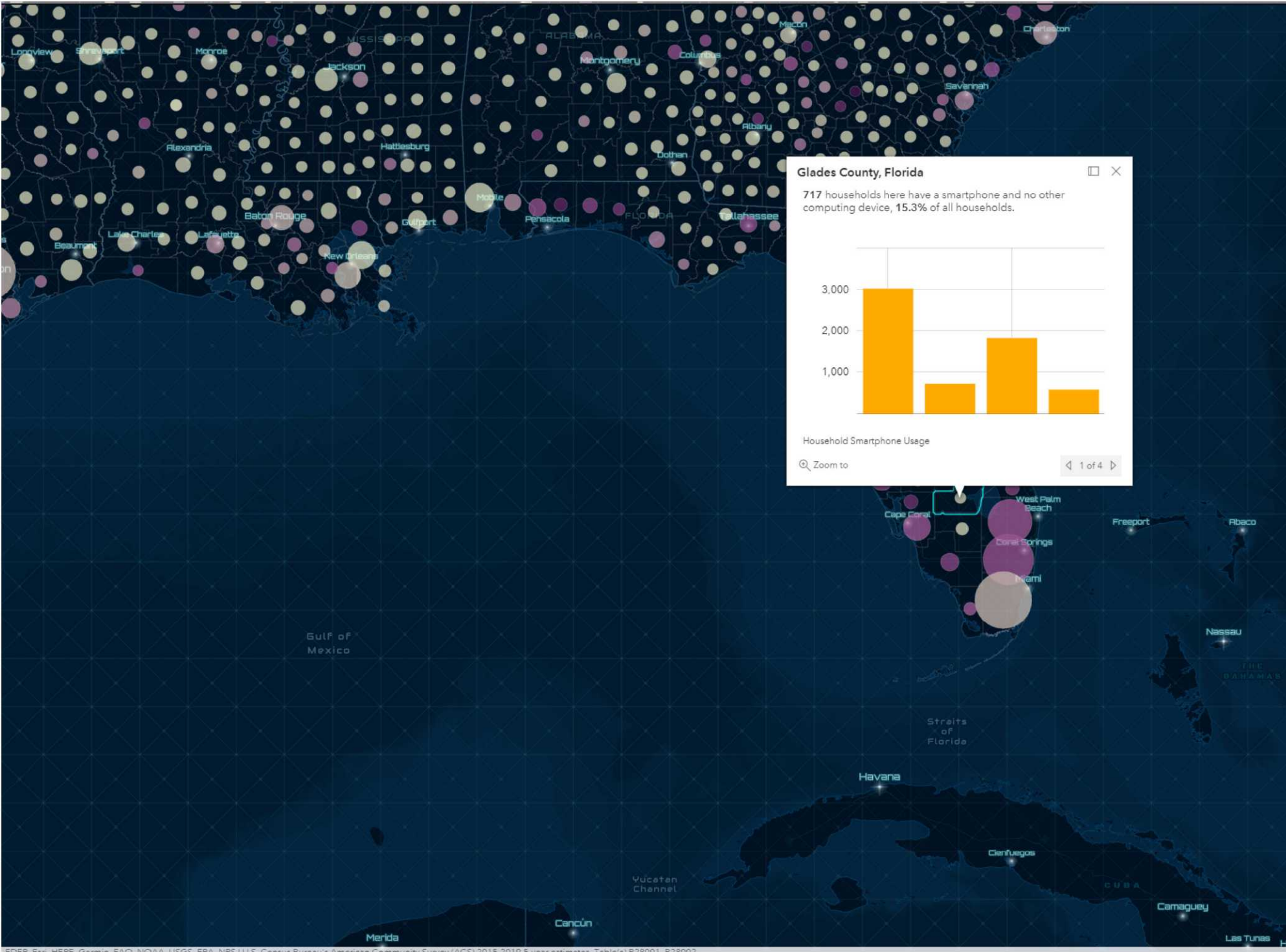

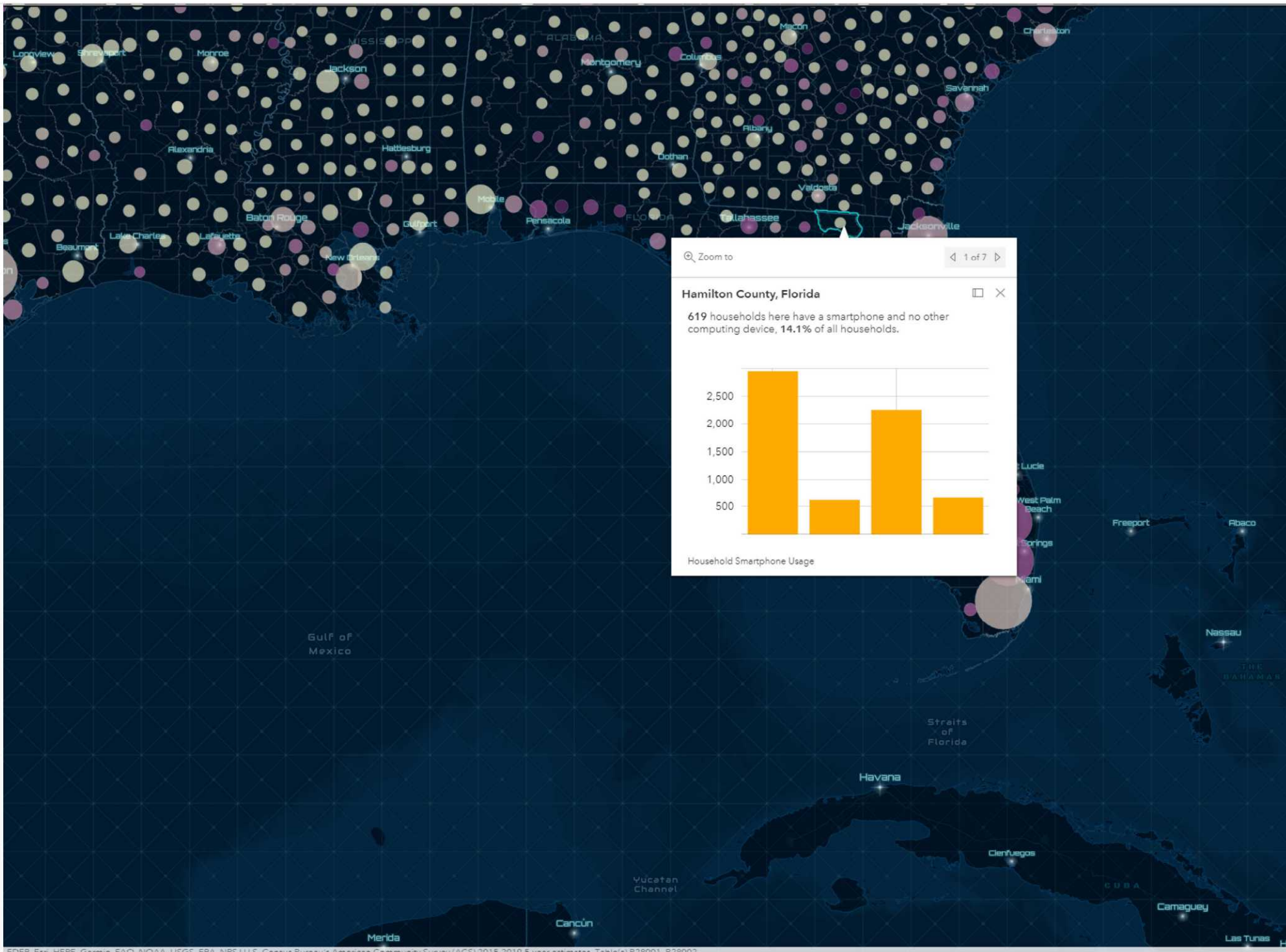
Household Smartphone Usage

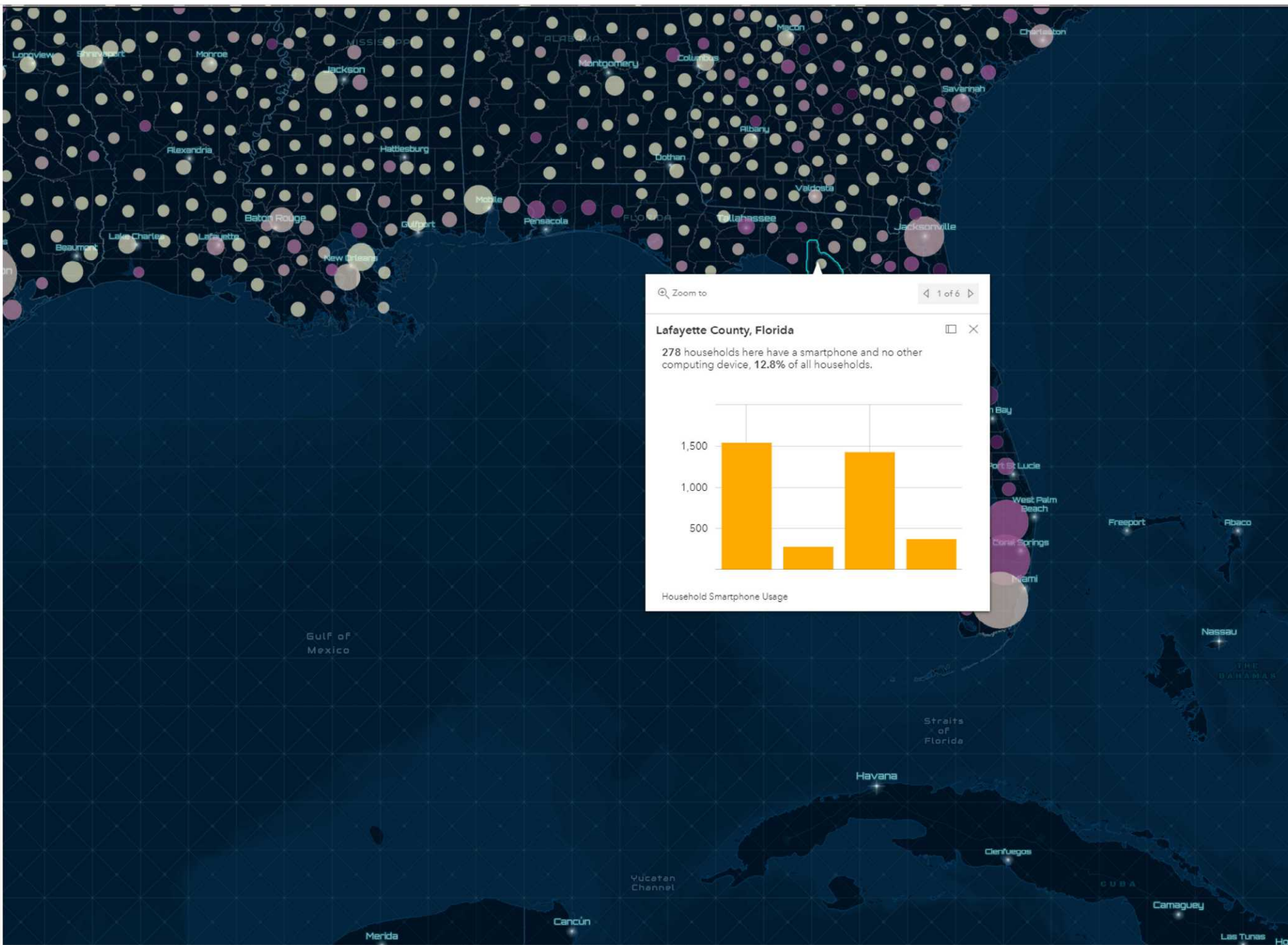

ne as their only computing device?



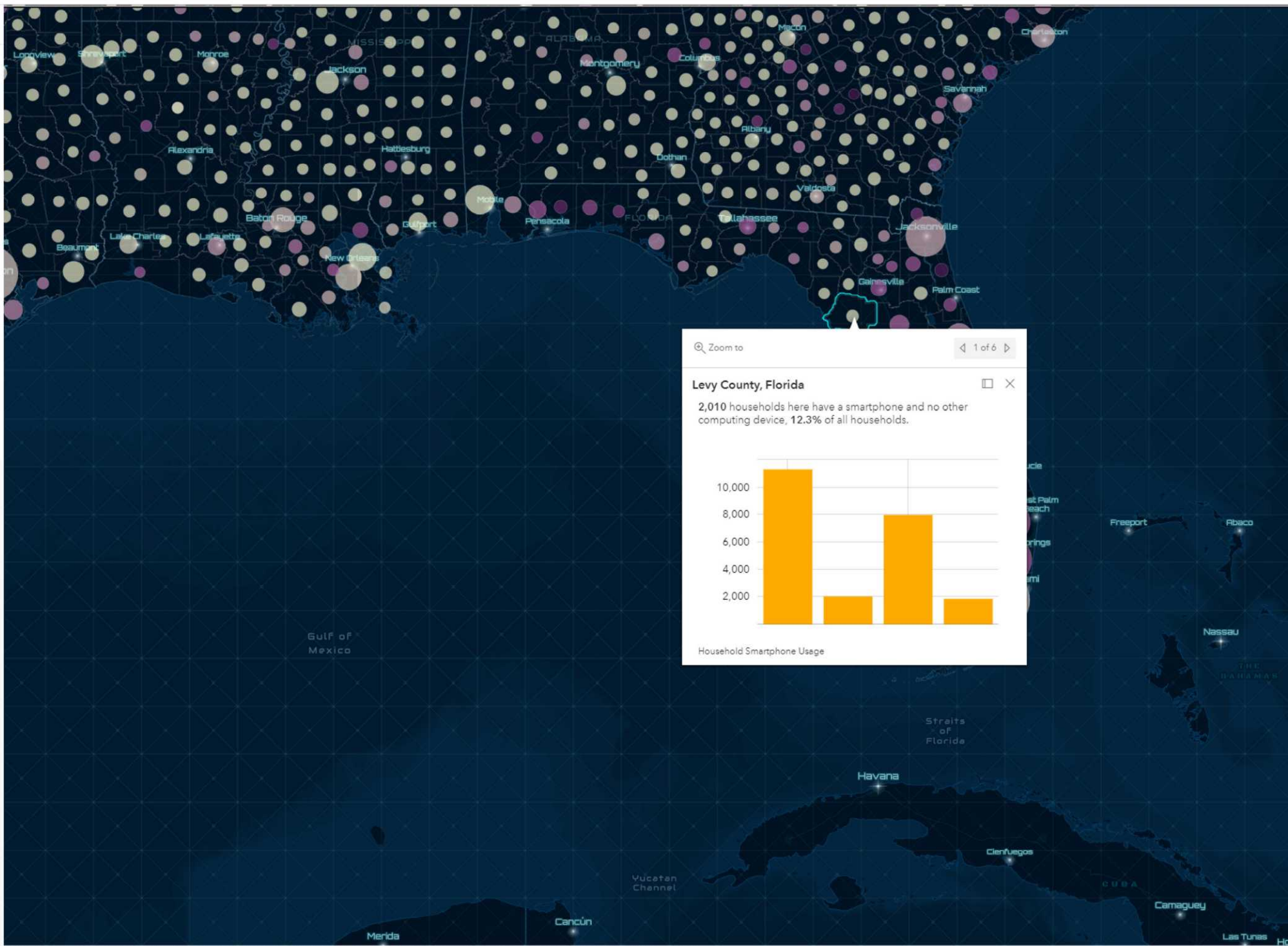
