I have been a member of the Florida Bar since 1984, and my license number is 434094. I am aware of the facts and circumstances surrounding Barry University's struggle to have its law school accredited and the subsequent penalty paid by those 109 graduates who have been forced to return to school due to the "12-month rule" in Florida, as this firm employs two Barry alumni/returning students.

I strongly support the petition to amend the 12-month rule. It would appear to me that the intent behind the current rules relating to bar admission are in place to ensure that the graduates taking the bar exam have graduated from a law school that has met certain standards. While I agree it is important to ensure a high level of education, the rule has not changed to reflect the changes in the ABA accreditation process, and the result has harmed over 100 individuals, including the two law clerks employed by this firm.

I urge this Honorable Court to adopt one of the proposals set forth in the petition to make certain that those law students/alumni from Barry who were caught up in the accreditation struggles and precluded from becoming licensed members of the bar be afforded full relief in the form of release of their bar exam results, and, where appropriate, admission to the Florida Bar. I would also request that this Honorable Court approve one of the proposals set forth in the petition to protect those students currently enrolled in FIU and FAMU's inaugural classes.
