He re-enrolled at the law school and he will be earning his second Juris Doctorate spring 2004. I was greatly disappointed that this Honorable Court, the Florida Bar and the Florida Board of Bar Examiners were unable to fashion a remedy, prior to this time, that would have allowed my son the opportunity to take the Florida Bar Examination with the real prospect of becoming licensed to practice law.

My son started law school at Barry in the fall of 1997 and full-filled his obligations as a full-time student to graduate in a timely manner. Several of his classmates prolonged or delayed their graduations in order to meet the 12-month rule requirement. Currently, those alumni have the same education as my son's however based on their dishonorable actions they have Florida Bar numbers.
