- I am a practicing attorney and current member of the Florida Bar. I am filing this
 pleading to express my opposition to the Grimes' Petition.
- 2. The Grimes' Petition seeks to avoid a test of Amendment 3's constitutional legality by making Amendment 3 a Bar rule, rather than allowing it to remain subject to attack in the courtroom.
- 3. The Grimes' Petition does nothing to further the interests of the Florida Bar, its members, our profession, or jurisprudence in general. The petition is simply an attempt by The Florida Medical Association to gain an advantage in litigation.
- 4. Amendment 3 results in an unconstitutional violation of a medical malpractice victim's rights to due process, equal protection, freedom of association, and access to courts.

The constitutionality of Amendment 3 is for the judiciary to determine and such issues

should not be avoided by the Grimes Petition in its suspect effort to change the rules of

professional conduct.

5. This petition makes an inappropriate attempt to change substantive law via rules

regulating professional conduct.

6. For the reasons stated above, I oppose the Petition and request that this Honorable

Court deny the Petition.
